PROJECT PROPOSAL

The Hungarian Reformed Church Aid – according to the attached report – helps daily the refugges arriving into the territory of Hungary. As You can see in the report from one side we are working in the Debrecen Refugee Camp of the Immigration and Citizenship Office of Hungary three days of a week. We are providing medical assistance once a week (general doctors, paediatricians, gynecologist womens). And we are providing the necessary medicines for the affected patients. Twice of a week we are providing special psichi-social support and palying-time to the children who lives in the camp.

We are monitorizing the evolved humanitarian crisis in our country and we are trying to help the people in need when and where is neccessary. Up to the present day the helped in Budapest, Bicske, Röszke, Zákány and Letenye. We spent 4-6 days on each critical field. Our team is ready and able to ensure the service fot 1000 people on every day. We are working together in co-coperation with the partner organizations, with the Ministry of Human Resources, with the Hungarian Police, with the Natioan Disaster Management and the Hungarian Military.

The general needs are the following:

- Food packagen for immediate usage (for muslim course)
- Drinking water (or hot tea in cold weather)
- Hyhienic packages (in small portions just for a few days)
- Coats, Jackets and warm clothing for adults
- Tents, blankets, matrasses, polifoams to provide emergency shelter
- For children and babies: chlothing, diapers, milk powder, baby food, vitamins, nursing bottles, etc.

Az You can see in the attached chart, the daily cost of the tenting of an adult is generally 10-20 EUR/person. The group of the refugees are changeing permanently. From this reason there is only a small part of the affected group whom really need the full day care. According to this facts the listed aid items are really neccessary for the daily service among the affected people.

We are collecting the listed items constantly in our warehouses and offices. But the negative propaganda and the cold public opinion is resulting a low donation rate in Hungary in the last days. We resume our efforts among the people in crisis but we have to rearrange our stock item capacities and we can plan only for the next two or three days. As we have new resources we are filling up our stock as we can.

In this case we are respectfully ask our partners, if You have any financial resources to support the humanitraian service of the refugees in Hungary by our work and efforts, please donate our organization in financial way.

According the the accurate plans the daily care of an adult refugge is 18,5 EUR. This is 18.500 EUR for the 1000 people. But our expreince in the last two is shows the daily cost is around 4000 EUR/day. The reason of the smaller amount is the continous travelling of the groups and our field workers are trying to reuse (recycle) the tents, blankets and matresses are in acceptable condition.

So the most important needs are in the next days are the following: buying food packages, water and polifoam matrasses.
